### **More than \$350,000 in capital improvements**

In 2010, we spent over a quarter of a million dollars building out physician office suites in our Medical Office Building. The additional square footage of physician office space will allow our patients to have faster access to quality healthcare services. ERMC also purchased the state-of-the-art GameReady® equipment to help our physical therapy and sports medicine patients recover faster from injuries. The staff at Ennis Regional Medical Center continues to provide quality healthcare services and is evidenced by greatly improved satisfaction scores received from our emergency room patients.

We invested more than \$350,000 in our facilities last year which, in addition to the above, included technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and important facility upkeep and maintenance.

### **Contributing to our local tax base**

Last year, Ennis Regional Medical Center paid over \$538,799 in property and sales taxes that have helped support our city, county and state. These dollars help support local schools, develop roads, recruit business and industry, and other vital community services.

### **Helping those In need**

Ennis Regional Medical Center provided more than \$56.5 million in uncompensated care last year, which included the amounts not covered by Medicare and Medicaid. This amount includes \$12 million for charity care and bad debt, incurred as we served many people without the financial resources to pay for basic health services.

### **Adding to the medical staff**

During the past year, Ennis Regional Medical Center added eight new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in general surgery, neurosurgery, cardiology, podiatry, pain management, otolaryngology, family medicine, and internal medicine. Ennis Regional Medical Center continues to recruit physicians who provide the best healthcare in Ellis County and surrounding areas.

### **One of our community's major employers**

Ennis Regional Medical Center gives back to its community not only by providing quality healthcare, but also by providing community involvement and support from staff physicians and employees.

In coordination with the Medical Staff, Ennis Regional provided over 200 free physicals to student athletes and boy scouts. Local physicians contributed their medical expertise, while ERMIC employees and Ennis ISD coaches provided volunteer hours to conduct the event.

Free sports physicals are an annual community service project at Ennis Regional Medical Center.

ERMIC also provided health services for the Ellis County Employee Health Fair in Waxahachie, Texas. Approximately 350 county employees took part in this event and ERMIC provided blood pressure checks, as well as blood glucose testing.

The Ennis Polka Festival is an annual event, attracting over 50,000 people to the area. Ennis Regional Medical Center provided first aid and water distribution during the event in 2010.

Ennis Regional Medical Center routinely collaborates with the Ennis Chamber of Commerce, the Ennis Lions Club, and other community organizations to provide for the citizens of Ellis County.
