Recruiting skilled clinicians to our hospital and community and supporting them in their new roles is critical to ensuring access to high-quality care. In 2024, we added 50 providers in areas such as Anesthesiology, Emergency Medicine, Family Medicine, and Radiology.

Last year, we spent more than \$100,000 on capital improvements, including new IV pumps, a laboratory refrigerator, and a feeding system.
